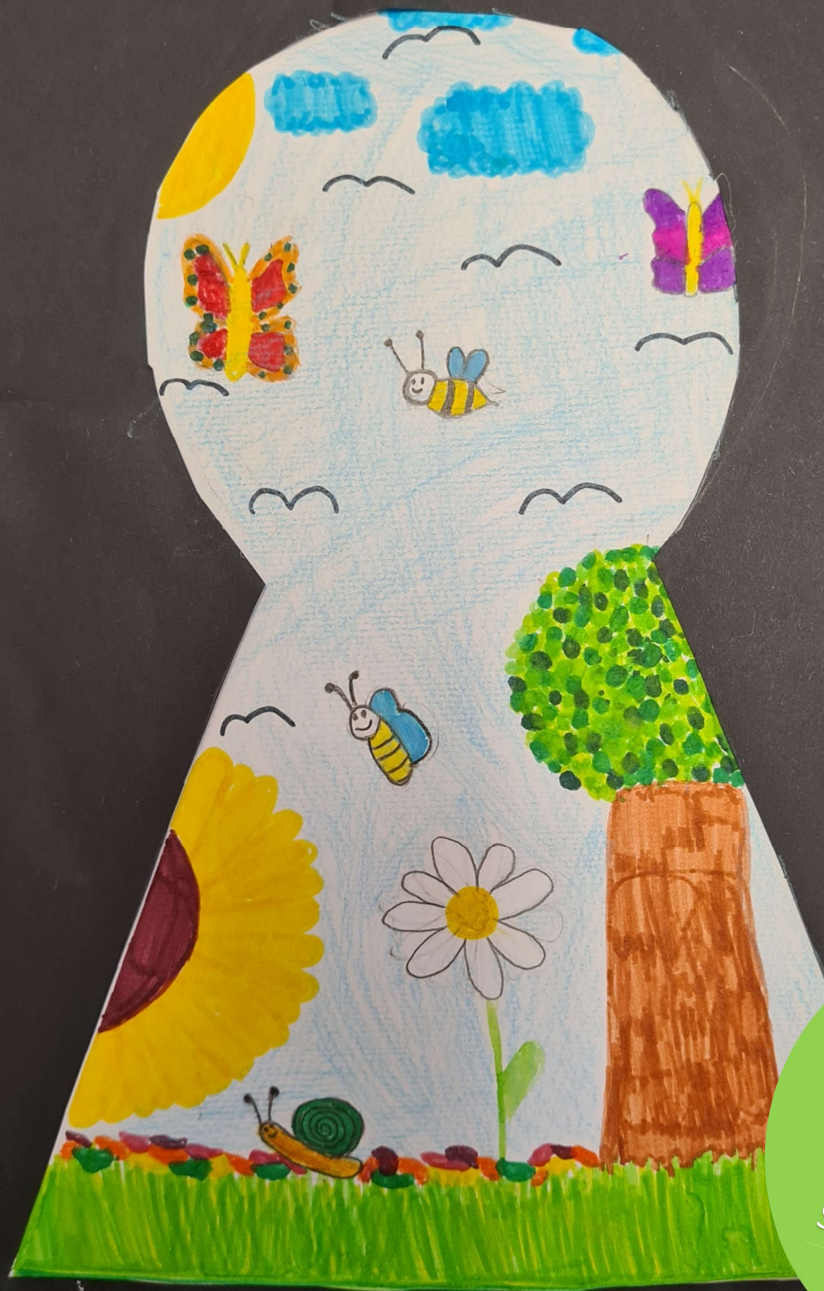

Book review:

Racism in Football



A lot of football players - like Léroy Sané or other black footballers - get hatred for missing an important or even non-important penalty or/and for performing badly on the pitch.

In the dressing room I could witness how hurt he felt and I can fully understand this, because I've experienced racist comments myself before a well.

It's really annoying and nothing to even make fun of.

Now this was my story - let's get back to what we are talking about.

Samuel Etóo and other black players back in the days also received a lot of hate comments which took over their mental health and made them perform badly on the pitch.

Football is already a hard sport and needs a lot of effort and good mentality, getting racist hatred will not make it easier - it will make it worse.

I think football clubs have to find a way of banning racists from the grounds.

I know it is not easy - even if it is hard to find those people among a crowd of 60.000 people or more.

As a footballer myself I can tell that mentality is the most important thing in football and I can say that I can't perform well when I get racist abuse. Even I train hard - mentality is everything.

I feel so sorry that some black footballers or other people have to suffer from racism. It is not cool and this topic gets me like crying over and over again because we are all the SAME.

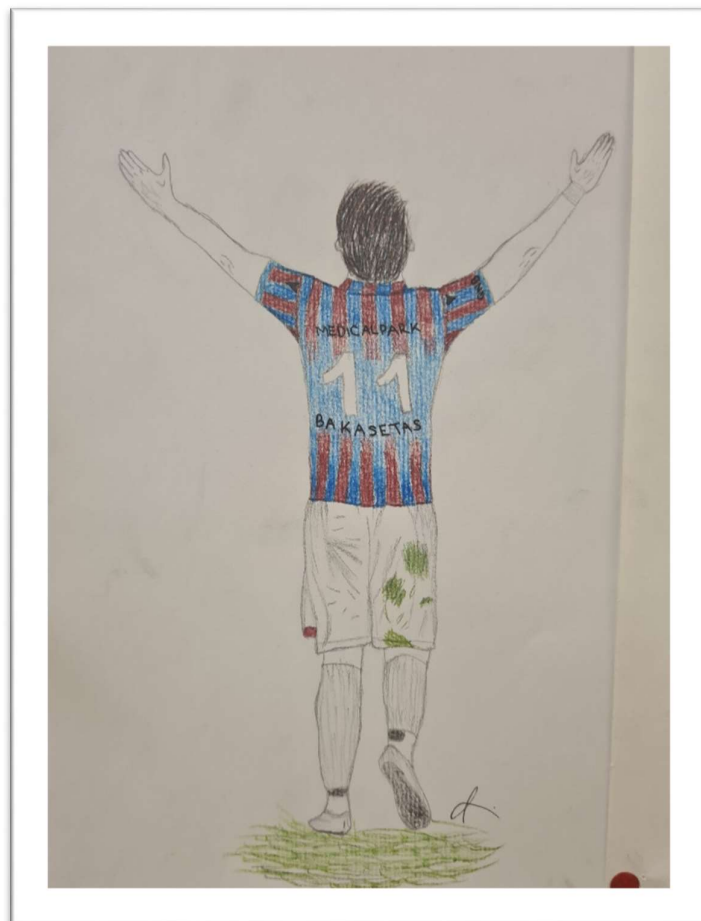
I don't think it matters if the skin is black or white.

Gruß aus der Schulküche

Schokoküchlein mit flüssigem Kern



ZUTATEN:

210 g	Butter
210 g	Dunkle Schokolade
7	Eier
270 g	Zucker
120 g	Mehl
40 g	Kakaopulver
	Fett für die Formen

1. Butter und Schokolade über Wasserdampf verflüssigen und kurz abkühlen lassen. Anschließend mit den Eiern und dem Kristallzucker schlagen und zum Schluss Mehl und Kakaopulver hinzufügen.
2. Backrohr auf 210 °C Heißluft vorheizen. Die Formen (ca. 7,5 cm Durchmesser und ca. 4 cm hoch) mit Butter einfetten und ungefähr 7 bis max. 10 Minuten backen. Die Formen nicht bis zum Rand auffüllen, da die Küchlein während des Backens noch etwas aufgehen.
3. Die Küchlein dann herausnehmen und noch warm genießen. Der Kern bleibt schön flüssig und schmeckt mit frischen Früchten, einem Beerenmus aus tiefgekühlten Beeren oder Vanilleeis superb.
